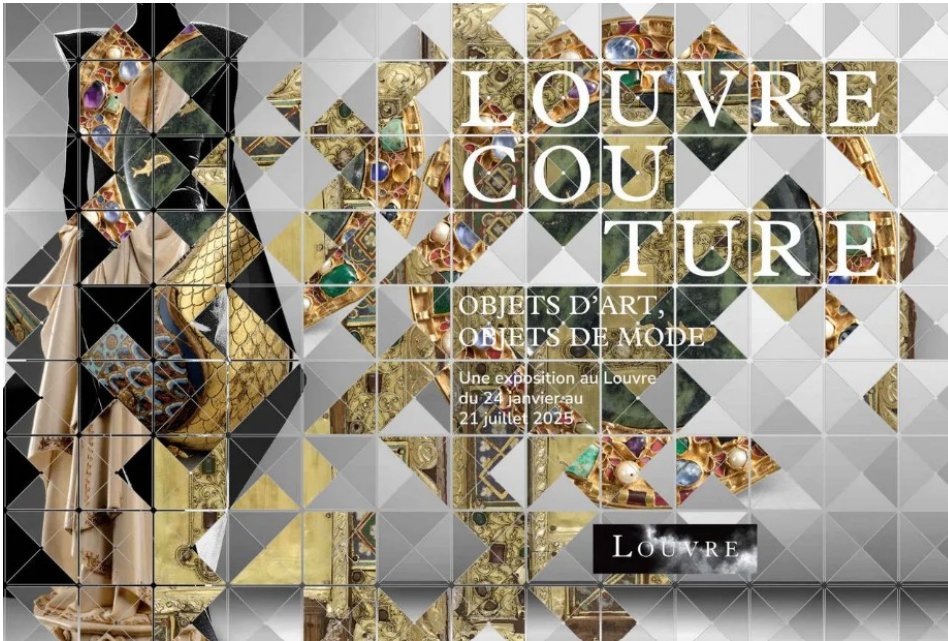

## NOTEWORTHY EXHIBITIONS



*This month we celebrate Spring, a season of rebirth, hope, renewal and new art exhibitions!*

Haute couture comes to the Louvre! Fashion will be on show at the Musée du Louvre until 21 July 2025. Presented in the rooms of the objects d'art department, the exhibition features a selection of silhouettes created by the greatest fashion designers, from Christian Dior to Chanel, Yves Saint Laurent, Versace, Dolce&Gabbana, and Alexander McQueen. For the first time ever, 65 Haute Couture outfits and their accessories are displayed in a 9,000-square-meter space alongside masterpieces from Byzantium to the Second Empire.

Visitors can see how fashion designers draw inspiration from historical and artistic collections.

### NOTEWORTHY EXHIBITIONS

The Thyssen-Bornemisza National Museum presents *Proust and The Arts*. Until 8 June 2025

To understand Proust it is important to know the Paris in which he lived; the cosmopolitan and rich capital of the Third Republic, its great transformation following Baron Hausmann's urban reforms, with the introduction of electricity, cars, public spectacles, restaurants and cafés.

This Temporary Exhibition includes paintings by Rembrandt, Vermeer, Van Dyck, Watteau, Turner, Fantin Latour, Manet, Monet, Renoir and Whistler, among others, a sculpture by Antoine Bourdelle. The exhibition includes a selection of books by Proust from the Bibliothèque nationale de France and Biblioteca del Ateneo de Madrid and other loans from the Musée du Louvre, the Musée d'Orsay and the Musée Carnavalet-Histoire in Paris, the Maurithuis in The Hague, and the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam.

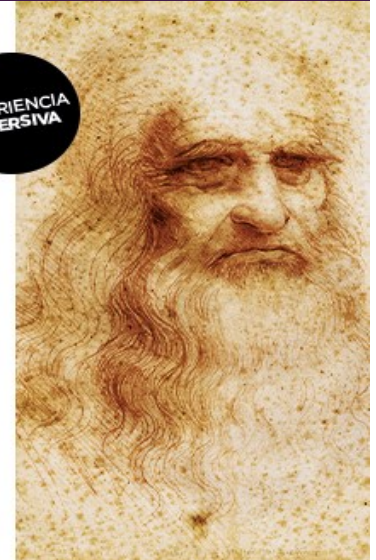

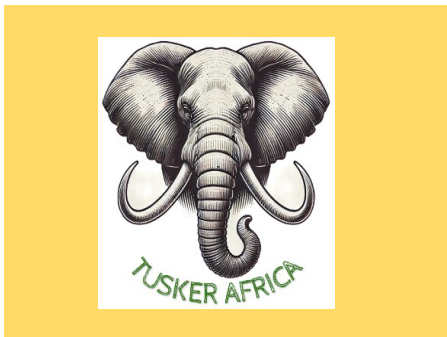
