NOTEWORTHY EXHIBITIONS

This Autumn's issue of What's On is focused on the upcoming major art exhibitions in Spain. In this issue you will also discover local art exhibitions that continue to showcase the talented artists in our Valencian Communidad.

The Museo Nacional Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum, Madrid inaugurates the Autumn season with two Temporary Exhibitions: *Picasso and Klee in the Collection of Heinz Berggruen* will feature selected masterpieces that explore the artists' unique visual and intellectual interplay. Exhibition dates are 28 October - 1 February 2026.

Warhol, Pollock and Other American Spaces is about an artistic dialogue between Andy Warhol and Jackson Pollock. From 21 October to 25 January 2026. This exhibition brings together the work of these two key names of 20th-century art, shown alongside that of other artists who were reconsidering issues relating to the new spatial strategies at this same time. Works from the Guggenheim Museum Bilbao Collection Until 12. 31.2025. This presentation of the Guggenheim Museum Bilbao Collection includes a selection of works that mark crucial moments in art history following World War II. In an ambitious gesture to underscore the resonance between art and architecture, this installation, which features some of the Collection's most outstanding pieces, showcases the original architecture of the building. The installation celebrates the luminous spaces of the third floor of the Museum. More+



The Prado in the Feminine Form. Museo Nacional Del Prado

The Prado in the Feminine Form, Artistic Patrons of the Museum's Collections (1701—1819) Museo Nacional Del Prado 1 December - 24 May 2026

Isabella of Farnese assembled one of the most important art collections of the 18th century, more than a third of which is in the Prado Museum. The signatures of Van Dyck, Brueghel the Younger, Clara Peeters, Velázquez, Ribera and Murillo are among the queen's paintings.

The new season of this exhibition is a tribute to the sovereign, who due to psychological problems of her husband, Philip V, ended up becoming, according to Cardinal Alberoni, "absolute mistress of the kingdom of Spain". She is particularly known for her great influence over Spain's foreign policy. From 1759 to 1760, she governed as regent. More+

David Bailey's Changing Fashion is a landmark exhibition celebrating the transformational impact of Bailey's photography in the 1960s and 1970s. Exchanging the mannered studio environment for the gritty reality of the streets, Bailey took the fashion world by storm. His work with his first great muse Jean Shrimpton set the revolutionary tone of the decade to come. Bailey is a master of musical portraiture. An enthusiastic trumpet player in his youth, Bailey has an instinctive understanding of what makes musicians tick. His earliest images of the Beatles and the Stones catch precisely the differences between the bands. In Martin Harrison's words, "The Stones loose and cavalier, Beatles buttoned up and controlled". Fancy seeing almost 100 world-class works of art? The BBVA Collection will be on full display in this exhibition opening 13 November that brings together 90 masterpieces. The exhibition includes everything from the great masters of the Renaissance to works by the pioneers of modern art. "...this exhibition represents the "jewels" of BBVA's extensive art holdings and marks the first time such a presentation has taken place at this museum".

The works span from the 15th to the early 20th century and include major artists like Murillo, Zuloaga, Van Dyck, Goya, Brueghel, and Sorolla. More+


Two venues in Jávea host new and colorful international exhibitions. Until 7 September 2025

The Drop of an Illusion exhibition of oil paintings, by Colombian artist Andrés Loboguerrero, brim with colour, energy, and tropical vitality. Simultaneously, the Casa del Cable, presents 'The Big Swing', the first solo exhibition in Spain of the French artist Victor. His work is a journey between abstraction and figuration, a territory where the subconscious, the rhythm of graffiti, childlike strokes, and music merge into spontaneous, hybrid, and highly expressive compositions.
